



Tariffs on Steel, Aluminum, Lumber

Tariffs on Steel and Aluminum

- 25% on steel, 10% on aluminum
 - ✓ Canada and Mexico dropped in April 2019
- Steel prices up ~40%, then down again
- Aluminum prices volatile
- Foreign retaliation



Retaliation Against \$40B in U.S. Exports






Steel Prices

USMCA's First Anniversary

Preserve U.S. Trade Ties to Canada and Mexico

- Supports 12 million American jobs
- Tops the next 11 largest markets for manufactures
- Accounts for one-third of all U.S. agricultural exports
- Services exports have tripled in 25 years

Strengthen North American Trade

New rules on digital trade, intellectual property, etc.

- Mexican energy sector, IP, ag/biotech access
- Labor cases
- Auto sector scuffles continue
- Canadian diary market access

U.S.-China Trade Tensions

- Broad agreement on diagnosis: Concerns about unfair trade, subsidies, IP theft, market access
- Broad opposition to tariffs as a remedy
 - \checkmark Tariff on \$350 billion of imports (7/18-now)

Cost of the U.S.-China Trade War

 ✓ IIF: \$40 billion in U.S. exports lost due to retaliation (900 product categories collapse)
 ✓ Hit to heartland: Soybean sales collapse; farm bankruptcies reach new high
 ✓ Fed: "100% of tariff" impact on Americans



Phase 1 Deal

- Halt to further tariff escalation; modest rollback
- Financial services, intellectual property, currency
- China's purchase of U.S. goods (met ~60%)
- But questions remain:
 - ✓ Will more tariffs be rolled back?
 - ✓ Huawei? Uyghurs? South China Sea?





U.S.-EU Trade: Big Benefits, Big Irritants

16 million jobs, \$5.5 trillion in sales

- ✓ Boeing and Airbus trade disputes resolved
- ✓ Digital Services Taxes on hold
- Privacy Shield (digital trade) talks stalled,
 "tech sovereignty" as EU goal
